Dr Jackson Mwewa's professional career can be evidently traced for over 15 years, as an accomplished social entrepreneur, humanitarian, leader, and an Apostle and a Minister of the gospel. He is currently the Chairman and CEO for National School of Leadership and Head of the University Studies under PhD Institute and Universidad Empresarial De Costa Rica (UNEM), with a mission to inspire, influence and create a legacy in society. Dr Mwewa is a lead founder of the national school of Leadership with international universities accreditation to teach, coordinate and certify academic and professional programmes at all levels Bachelors, Masters and PhDs.

Some of the professional involvements include Technical Consultant - Adolescent Health with American International Health Alliance (AIHA) to lead the technical local experts in developing the curricula and training materials on Adolescent Health course for Defence School of Health Sciences.

Dr. Mwewa was engaged as National Lead Consultant and Facilitator in Zambia for Global Refugee Consultations for UNHCR and United Nations Women Refugee Commission (UNWRC) on youth consultations for inclusion of youth participation, as a Lead Consultant for Zambia Federation of Disability Organisations (ZAFOD) to assess ZAFOD's organizational capacity and develop Governance structure – that includes the board and management, as National Trainer/Consultant under Ministry of Health – Counselling & Mental Health training unit to train in child, couple and psychosocial counsellors, and build capacity in Community and clinic based educators and in HIV and AIDS.

He worked as Consultant for Paralegal Alliance Network in Zambia in designing and developing training manual in HIV/AIDS, Disability, Child Rights and Gender Resource, train and provide capacity building on legal and advocacy and prison monitoring work.

A Consultant for Mental Health Users Network of Zambia (MHUNZA) to design organisation development systems, develop a governance structure for the organisation new and strategic plan towards sustainable interventions programmes on mental health and psychosocial wellbeing.

He worked as Programmes Coordinator with Centre for Infectious Disease Research in Zambia, in designing the HIV community led prevention program and provided technical support to community teams' Male circumcision, TB, Cervical Cancer and Pediatrics.
